#### **Conditions of Entry**

- Maiden Horses are not eligible to compete. In the event of a legitimate complaint of a maiden entry, that entry will forfeit all points and rights to winning any prizes at the campdraft.
- 2. The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse with exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement Campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating e.g if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft.

- All horses must be ridden in order of the draw and any changes must be decided on by the disputes committee.
- Nomination fees must be included with entries. Telephone entries will not be accepted. Release and waiver must be signed by the competitor.
- In the event of excess nominations restrictions may apply.
- Unless otherwise advised, competitors can regard their entries as having been accepted, but the Warwick Show and Rodeo Society Inc will in no way be responsible for non receipt of entries.
- 9. Twenty percent (20%) of first round competitors will compete in the second round, after which, the leading twenty (20) competitors at least will compete in the final (except Ascot Charolais & Angus Champion of Champions Campdraft and the Frasers Livestock Transport Stallion Campdraft). The competitor gaining the highest aggregate of points throughout the contest shall be the winner.
- 10. Owners of horses must state when nominating, the order in which they wish their horses to compete. All horses starting from number one (1) must follow correct order. Failure to observe this condition will result in your horse, possibly being disqualified.
- 11. No rider under the age of seventeen (17) years will be allowed to compete.
- 12. Riders under the age of 18 must wear a helmet whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- 13. Any rider wishing to be eligible for the Associate Rider (a competitor aged from 17 years and under 21 years) or the Master Rider (a competitor aged 55 years and over) must nominate their age on their entry form. If this is not done, they wil not be eligible for these or associated awards.
- 14. Any horse / rider wishing to be eligible for Australian Stock Horse or Australian Quarter Horse awards or associated awards must nominate the relevant ASH or QH rego number on their entry form. If this is not done, they will not be eligible for these or associated awards.
- 15. Gates open for competitors camping 7am Saturday 21 October 2017.
- 16. An eligible substitute horse will be allowed when the nominated horse cannot start. The name of the substitute horse MUST be in the hands of the Secretary as per the 'Order of Events'.

- 17. Cancelled or withdrawn entries must be via website or submitted in writing to the Campdraft Secretarial Office. A 100% refund of the entry fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 7 days prior to 8am on the morning of the program. 7 days before and more than 3 days prior to 5am on the morning of the progam a levy of 20% per entry (capped at \$50) will be retained to cover administration costs and stock levy for cancelled or withdrawn entries. Refer Rule D.5 and D.6 If a competitor withdraws within 72 hours prior to 5am on the morning of the program the full entry will be retained unless a veterinary/medical certificate is provided and/or there are extenuating circumstances when a levy capped at \$50 will be retained. Scratchings and any changes must be made in writing.
- 18. Stallion Containment Requirements refer NCCA rule
  11.12
- Temporary fences are to be no more than 4m x 4m per horse. NO FENCES are to be pre erected or erected off the stables or stable area.
- Due to the limited area available for camping, only horses competing in any of the five (5) drafts are permitted on the grounds.
- 21. All dogs must be restrained at all times at their camp. Chains are to be no longer than one (1) metre in length. No dogs allowed in public areas. Any dog found unrestrained will be removed from the grounds.
- 22. Prize money will be paid within 10 working days.
- 23. Please note that all scratching and refunds will not be processed until after the conclusion of the event and will be direct credited directly to competitors.
- 24. Whilst it is not compulsory, the Society stongly encourages riders to wear safety helmets.
- 25. Please ensure syringes are disposed of correctly.

- 27. The decision of the Warwick Show & Rodeo Society Inc.
  Committee on all matters pertaining or incidental to the competition shall be final and conclusive and binding on all nominations for the competitions and in addition, the Committee reserves unto itself the right, at any time, without being liable for any loss or damage which may be sustained, to alter or postpone the date of the competitions or cancel the same or change the venue of the competitions. The Committee reserve the right to limit nominations of any campdraft/s depending on the availability of cattle.
- 28. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited.
- 29. Competitors must be a member of the ACA.
- Horse Health Declarations / Bio-Security / Tick Declaration forms must be completed before entering the grounds.
- 31. Warwick Veterinarian Clinic is our Official vets onsite. No other Veterinarian is to be allowed to provide veterinary services on the grounds without the approval of our Biosecurity Officer, who can be contacted through the office.
