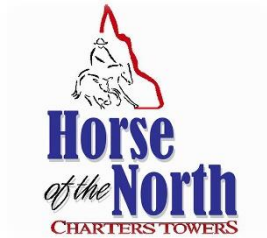

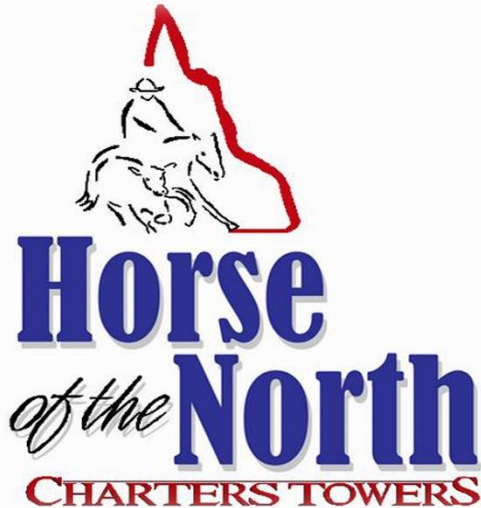

Gun of the North is the only Farrier Competition held in Northern Queensland. It was created to encourage the pursuit of knowledge and farrier skills among our Horsemen and Women. Gun of the North has grown to be an integral part of the Horse of the North as a Saturday Morning Pre Runner to the finals of our Challenge. Held in two divisions, the Gun of the North hosts a cold shod Non Pro Division and a hot shod Professional Division.

If an Under 25yrs rider makes the Classic and Under 25yrs final on the same horse they will run in the Classic final only and will not be required to show their horse a second time in the under 25yrs final.
