This agreement is made and entered into by the Mare owner who agrees to breed the broodmare listed in the **Application for Service** on page 1, to The Metallist during 2024 breeding season, under the terms and conditions listed below.

BREEDING FEE - A breeding Fee of \$3500 (GST inclusive) is agreed and payable in full when Steven Hart (the Stallion owner) has granted approval.

This completed breeding contract must be returned to the Stallion owner along with the mare's registration papers. All payments must be made to the following bank details:

CHARGES - No semen will be shipped, and no mare will be covered until the breeding fee is received.

Additionally, the Mare owner agrees to pay all charges applicable to the mare and/or progeny for:

- Semen shipment
- Semen collection
- Stallion transport for collection
- Agistment fees
- All Veterinary expenses, treatments, examinations, procedures, operations, and medicines administered by a Veterinarian, the Stallion owner, employees of the Stallion owner, or others; and
- any other costs incurred by the Stallion owner during the mares and/or progeny's stay.
- If more than one foal results from an embryo flush, an additional stallion service fee will be due and payable to the stallion holder upon each successful pregnancy of said embryo(s).

Interest will be charged at the current commercial rate plus collection costs will be charged on all outstanding monies.

SHIPMENT OF SEMEN - is organised and payable by the Mare owner, including rebreeds.

The vet and Stallion owner will ship the highest quality semen, however, makes no guarantees or warranties and shall not be held liable for contamination or damage of semen during or after shipment, loss of viability or any costs arising from shipments delayed, damaged or lost in transit. All freight costs for freight to breeding centre and for returning unused semen to semen storage facility are separate from this contract and payable by the Mare owner.

All semen is still the property of the Stallion owner and may not be collected, stored, distributed or sold by any other party. Semen will only be shipped to approved veterinary hospitals. Semen is dispatched in one dose lots.

VETERINARY PROCEDURES AND EXPENSES - will be separately invoiced by the relevant vet clinic and are payable by the Mare owner.

Vet services for the mare and/or progeny will be conducted at the discretion of the Stallion owner in consultation with the vet and Mare owner (where possible). The Mare owner commits that the details of the broodmare listed in the **Application for Service** form are true and correct and that the broodmare must be healthy and in sound breeding condition, which is to be certified by a qualified veterinarian before the mare is served. Current worming and vaccination dates are to be supplied.

All mares must be controllable and be able to lead. Diligent efforts will be made to settle the mare, however, if a mare does not settle for any reason, the Mare owner agrees to hold the Stallion owner blameless. The Stallion owner reserves the right to

refuse any mare for service. The Mare owner agrees that the Stallion owner will not be responsible for any disease, accident, sickness or death to the owner's mare and/or progeny.

The contract will not be assigned or transferred by the Mare owner and if the abovementioned mare is sold, the service fee and/or any other outstanding fees will immediately become due and payable by the Mare owner. If the broodmare dies or becomes unfit to be served, then no service fee will be charged.

LIVE FOAL GUARANTEE - The Mare owner must notify the Stallion owner of the pregnancy status of the mare as soon as the mare is checked for pregnancy, whether the mare is pregnant or not.

If the mare aborts or the foal does not stand to nurse, the Mare owner may return the mare for rebreeding during the following breeding season only, and no breeding fee will be charged. To be entitled to such rebreeding the Mare owner must deliver to the Stallion owner a certificate by a licensed veterinarian, attesting that the mare aborted or that the foal did not stand and nurse. The certificate must be delivered within ten (10) days of the date that the mare aborts or the foal is born.

The right of breeding privileges may not be granted to mares leaving a breeding facility prior to the end of the breeding season before a positive pregnancy examination by the veterinarian is performed. The live foal guarantee may be cancelled if the Mare owner returns the mare to work/competition after a positive pregnancy test.

If the mare is sold, dies, or is unsuitable for breeding, then the right to a live foal guarantee is cancelled.

OTHER - A Certificate of Registration, as issued by the ASHS, AQHA, or other relevant breed societies must accompany the Application for Service form.

Upon foaling, the Mare owner will be responsible for preparing any relevant documentation to the relevant breeding society. ASHS and AQHA breeding certificates will not be issued unless the abovementioned mare is registered with the ASHS and AQHA at the time of signing this contract. Non-registered mares can be covered. If a late stallion breeding return is needed, the Mare owner is liable to pay the late fee required by ASHS and AQHA.

The Stallion owner will provide all care, good husbandry, and attention to the mare and/or progeny in their charge. However, the Stallion owner and stud management takes no responsibility for injury, sickness, disease or death of any mare and/or progeny while in their care. When Mare owner signs and returns one copy of this contract with payment to the Stallion owner, and it has been approved it will be a binding contract on both parties subject to the above terms and conditions.
